THE ART OF THE PUSH UP

MAYBELLINE NEW YORK ASSISTANT VICE PRESIDENT OF RESEARCH AND INNOVATION, GRACEMARIE PAPALEO. GIVES THE SCOOP ON HOW TO CREATE FALSE LASHES IN A TUBE

Q - HOW DOES THE PUSH UP BRUSH WORK?

GP — Falsies Push Up Drama has a new Brush technology. The bristles have a new shape to retain a maximum amount of formula inside "reservoirs," and to deliver an immediate charge on lashes. There are an essential number of bristles on the brush to increase product deposit. It also separates. Lastly, the unique "wiper" and stem/wand helps to boost and lift the charge

0 — WHAT'S THE BENEFIT OF THE 45-DEGREE LIFT?

GP — Pushing lashes up and fanning them out makes the eyes look bigger.

Q — HOW IS PUSH UP DRAMA DIFFERENT THAN OTHER PLUMPING MASCARAS?

GP — We used a new formulation approach and new packaging conception to deliver "immediate quick volume." It usually takes five to ten coats before you can begin to really build the volume, but combined with the unique brush, Push Up provides big volume in the first few strokes. Plus, a new combination of an adhesive polymer and soft waxes give big volume that feels lightweight.

Q — HOW MANY VERSIONS DID YOU TEST BEFORE YOU DECIDED ON THE FINAL ONE?

GP — We screened dozens of formulas, and over ten brushes before landing on the perfect combination for launch

Q — GOT ANY SPECIFIC APPLICATION TIPS FOR THIS UNIQUE NEW WAND?

GP — For the best results, sweep lashes from root to tip. Repeat until the desired amount of lift and volume are achieved. Start at the base of the lashes and swipe upward with a lifting action to push and stretch the lashes. Use the tip of the brush to reach outer and inner corner lashes. Twist the brush as needed during application to fully access the formula. For smoother application, don't let the mascara dry between coats.

Q — WHEN YOU'RE WEARING A REALLY DRAMATIC LASH LOOK, DO YOU FEEL LIKE YOU CARRY YOURSELF DIFFERENTLY? DESCRIBE HOW IT CHANGES YOUR ATTITUDE, CONFIDENCE, ETC.

GH — I always have more confidence when I know my lashes look good.

Q — WHY ARE LASHES SUCH A KEY PART OF CREATING A SEXY MAKEUP LOOK?

GH — They make your eyes look bigger and brighter, which makes the rest of your makeup look stand out.

Q — DO YOU REMEMBER THE FIRST TIME YOU EVER WORE MASCARA? DO TELL!

GH — The first time I wore mascara was probably when I was little and playing in my mom's makeup drawer.

Q — WHEN YOU ONLY HAVE FIVE MINUTES TO DO YOUR MAKEUP FOR AN EVENT, WHAT IS YOUR GO-TO LOOK?

GH — I put on mascara and a bit of bronzer!

Q — GOT ANY TIPS FOR APPLYING MASCARA OR APPLYING IT ON THE GO?

GH — Make sure you cover the roots well and then follow through to the tip. In the back of a cab, it's best to do the roots at a red light and finish up the ends once the car starts moving again.

Q — WHAT DO YOU LOVE THE MOST ABOUT THE FALSIES PUSH UP DRAMA BRUSH?

GH — I love that it lifts the lashes from the root. Mascara that lifts and creates volume is perfect for my eye shape.

Q — WHAT OTHER MAKEUP PRODUCTS WOULD YOU WEAR FALSIES PUSH UP DRAMA WITH DURING THE DAY? HOW WOULD YOU ROCK IT AT NIGHT?

For his first ever project for Maybelline New York, the London-based, father of two took his inspiration from nightlife in The Big Apple. Here, he explains exactly what vibe he was going for.

0 - HOW DID YOU GET INTO DIRECTING?

JAKE NAVA — My first video was for an artist called Misty Oldland. The song was "Got Me A Feeling" featuring Omar. It was an acid jazz style track. I've always been focused on making the people in front of my camera look their best. Of course, what 'best' means is very different depending the project, the type of artist or the brand I'm working with.

Q — HOW DID YOU LAND YOUR GIG WITH MAYBELLINE NEW YORK?

JN — Mostly by being persistent. I have long admired the unique visual aesthetic that Maybelline has managed to carve out in the beauty world—something that's hard to do in a saturated market. Maybelline has retained a strong creative position in this space, and I wanted to be a part of the ongoing success.

Q-WHATWASTHEATMOSPHERELIKEONSET?

JN — We were shooting a lot of material for several different spots, so there was a momentum and energy that was fun. It got intense at times, though!

Q — WHAT WAS THE CONCEPT FOR THE TV COMMERCIAL AND DIGITAL FILM?

JN — For the TV spot, I used vivid colors to capture the fun and confidence that comes from being in one of the most energetic cities in the world. The digital piece has a tone that's fresh, urban and authentic. It's about savvy young women that know who they are, and aren't afraid to show it.

Q — DID YOU HAVE AN ULTIMATE GOAL IN MIND FOR THE PROJECT?

JN — It was important to me that the films feel authentic to the glamorous young lifestyles of the 'It girl' models we were using. I wanted the spot to merge iconic beauty and fashion with a slightly more raw and real approach that evoked the cool way these girls actually live.
